

Marian High School Omaha, Nebraska

As part of an overall master planning effort, Holland Basham Architects was retained by Marian High School to provide full architectural services and design for the addition of a new gymnasium and commons area.

The project added 19,000 s.f. of space, including a 1000-seat gymnasium, locker rooms, training room, commons areas, and an elevator to provide access to the three levels. The locker rooms are situated between the existing practice gymnasium and the new competitive play gymnasium.

The existing restrooms were renovated to provide additional fixtures for the increased gymnasium occupancy and accessible facilities. The existing locker rooms were removed and converted into part of the new commons area joining the commons link with the cafeteria. A concessions area was added adjacent to the gymnasium which also serves as a breakfast bar.

In addition, HBA also provided full architectural services and design for the 16,635 s.f addition of a new library, guidance center and administrative office building.
