

University of Nebraska-Omaha Roskens Hall College of Education Omaha, Nebraska

HBA provided design services for the renovation of Roskens Hall on UNO's Dodge Campus. Roskens Hall is the former home of UNO's College of Business Administration, which has relocated to the new Mammel Hall on the Pacific Campus (for which HBA also provided design services). The renovated Roskens Hall is now the new home for UNO's College of Education.

The renovation involves five of the six building levels and encompasses 83,770 s.f. It addresses a need for additional space in the College and includes flexible learning environments, classrooms and labs with full media capabilities, informal study areas and collaboration spaces, and inviting faculty and administrative offices to increase interaction between faculty and students. The project also features an exterior pedestrian plaza and a new, two-story addition that encloses a student commons area and function as the building's entrance on the north side. This new entrance creates presence on Dodge Street and anchor the northeast corner of UNO's campus.

The College of Education's move to Roskens Hall allows for the growth of programmatic, support and service efforts and respond to new/evolving curriculum featuring STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics). This expansion in programs and curriculum generates greater opportunities to engage and serve the Omaha and Nebraska educational community.
