

University of Nebraska at Omaha Scott Residence Hall Omaha, Nebraska

This first residence hall on UNO's campus was completed in 2000. The 2nd, 3rd and 4th floors contain typical resident suites, a faculty apartment, student storage, environmental services space, lounge spaces, student kitchen, and an ADA-accessible resident suite with an adjoining resident assistant suite that doubles as an ADA overflow suite. Students can utilize the dining hall/food court area of the Commons Building which can be accessed via a connecting link.

Each typical suite is provided with 4 individual bedrooms. Each bedroom is equipped with a bed, chair, student desk, and individual voice and data outlets. A common living room is provided in each suite for student interaction.
