In collaboration with internationally recognized Gensler Architects, Holland Basham Architects is the Architect of Record for the University of Nebraska-Omaha's new Mammel Hall College of Business Administration located on the Pacific Campus. The \$34 million facility not only serves as a gateway to the campus but provides state-of-the-art instructional facilities within 121,670 s.f. of space. Mammel Hall provides an increased number of classrooms, a 200-seat auditorium, multiple collaboration areas, and improved faculty offices allowing for increased interaction with students. A three-story atrium is the featured design element that links the many different uses and provides a space to encourage collaboration between the students and faculty.

With increasing enrollment, growth is expected to be significant. The new facility not only allows the College of Business Administration to meet the growth but allows the college to foster and expand its relationships with representatives of the local and international business communities. To further reinforce the College's forward thinking and commitment to not only the community but also the environment, the facility pursued and received LEED – Gold Certification, a first at the University of Nebraska-Omaha campus.
